**Ninth Annual Shoreline Sightseeing St. Patrick's Day Lunch Cruises

Two ninety-minute cruises are available; the pre-parade cruise departs at 10:00 a.m., returning at 11:30 a.m., and the post-parade cruise departs at 2:00 p.m., returning at 3:30 p.m. Cruises leave from Shoreline's dock at the southwest corner of Polk Bros Park at Navy Pier. In addition to the St. Patrick's Day Lunch Cruises, Shoreline will run guided Architecture River Tours on Saturday and Sunday (March 14 and 15) weather permitting. These 75-minute cruises will depart from two locations: southwest corner of Polk Bros Park at Navy Pier and northeast corner of the Michigan Avenue Bridge.
